

Pen-y-ffordd Tennis Club

Club Rules

Use of Pen-y-ffordd Tennis Club is subject to the following conditions, which must be adhered to at all times:

- Tennis shoes only must be worn when on the playing surfaces.
- The courts are available for play 9.00am-10.00pm Monday-Saturday, 10.00am-9.00pm Sunday.
- A high standard of behaviour must be maintained at all times (e.g. no excessive noise/bad language that may upset nearby residents).
- The combination padlock, when removed to open the gate, must be locked to the fence with the numbers scrambled (so that a non-member cannot gain access to the code).
- The combination padlock must be used to securely lock the gate on leaving the premises.
- The combination code must not be shared with anyone else.
- Members may bring non-members as guests by payment of the prevailing guest fee, which must be paid via the website **before** using the facilities.
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere on the site.
- Tennis balls may only be retrieved from nearby gardens when they are clearly visible.
- If fewer than 4 members / members and their guest(s) are using a court when all courts are full and people are waiting, members are encouraged to mix in and play doubles matches.
- Under 18s must not be left unsupervised in the clubhouse.
- Clubhouse key-holders must abide by the agreement they signed when receiving the key (as detailed at <http://www.penyfforddtennisclub.com/clubhouse-keys>).
