Gentle REMINDERS

Parking - Please only park in the designated spaces by the courts to park. If these are full, there is plenty of parking on Vounog Hill.

Court Bookings - Please can we ask that you only book *One* court at a time. Multiple court bookings ("Side-by-side") by one member are not allowed. please remember to add the names of all players/members who will be present.

Cancelling Courts/Floodlights - If, for any reason, you cannot play and no longer need a court that you've booked, kindly ensure you cancel the booking promptly. This helps in maximising court availability for other members. Additionally, if you are playing under floodlit courts and finish early, please can you END booking. This will turn off the floodlights. By doing so, both our neighbours and the environment can benefit, THANK YOU. (There is a 10min shutdown window for the lights)

Children - It is recommended children under 13 are supervised by a parent or guardian when at the club. Additionally, under 18s must always be supervised in the clubhouse. Parents are responsible for any juniors playing unsupervised.

Clubhouse Security - When you unlock the clubhouse, it is your responsibility to ensure the door is locked before you leave. The T&C's can be found on our website under Facilities.
